In writing this thesis conducted a library research to answer all the questions that are presented in the problem formulation. To get the feminism value the writer uses qualitative research as the method to analyze the relationship between social inequality and feminism theory.

Based on the analysis, the result of the study is follows. First, social inequality as enacted by Elizabeth Bennet in Pride and Prejudice novel, such as income, social status and talent. And the second answer about woman's struggle as enacted by Elizabeth Bennet in Pride and Prejudice novel, such as struggle to against physical oppression and struggle to against psychological oppression.

She must not only face her mother, a distant father, two younger sister which do not like her, several antagonistic females, she must also overcome her own mistaken impressions of Darcy, which initially lead her to reject his proposals of marriage.

From the reason above, the researcher tooks the previous study to do the research. The first previous study was conducted Wilujeng (2014). She describes the theory feminism from Wild Child Movie and the researcher use Feminism approach. The method used qualitative method to identifying the data of Poppy in "Wild Child" Movie, Classifying the data based on the feminism of Poppy's in "Wild Child" Movie. She described about kind of intimidation experienced by main character and how the main character shows the feminism ideas in her fighting against the intimidations she experienced in *Mona Lisa Smile* film by analyzing the evidences from the dialogues in the film, her acts, and her statement. To get the feminist value the writer uses Descriptive-Qualitative analysis as the method to analyze the relationship between the main character and feminism theory. On the instrument, the researchers use the data is qualitative bullying imposed on main character and how main character can survive from intimidation received.

The third previous study was conducted Rianto (2010). REVIEW OF RELATED LITERATURE

The socialist feminism was born to respond to the Marxist feminism point of view, which according to the socialist on of gender is blind. It states that living in the capitalist society is not the only reason of women's state of under development, but it is also because of patriarchal society. In the perspective of social feminism, the capitalist and patriarchal systems are the real social relationship that dominates women.

1. Social inequality enacted by Elizabeth Bennet that taken in *Pride and Prejudice* novel by Jane Austen

a. Monadic and relational attributes

Monadic attributes is any property of a given unit (individual, family, community, etc.) whose magnitude can be defined without any reference to other units. Relational attributes can definite without other attributes.

1. Income

Income is one of the examples. Income includes the revenue streams from wages, salaries, interest on a savings account, dividends from shares of stock, rent, and profits from selling something for more than you paid for it. Income inequality refers to the extent to which income is distributed in an uneven manner among a population. In this novel, I found that only man can get and have income but woman have not income. It was due to the difference work where in that era just a man who may work. Income in this novel can describe like next heir, large property, and money. It is can make a man have high income and social inequality for women.

2. Social status

Not only income, but social status is also generally an example of relational attribute. Status is intrinsically a relational attribute in that 'high' status only has meaning relative to lower statuses. In this novel, I found that high status can described by Mr. Darcy's family and lower status can describe by Elizabeth Bennet social status. It caused because of the education by Elizabeth and the status of her family. Social status aspect can describe like rich, respectable man, next heir, and the high level of education.

b. Monadic and relational process

Monadic and relational process is certain unequally distributed attributes are acquired through what can be called a monadic process. For the example is talent.

1. Talent

Talent is an example of a relational attribute that is unequally distributed through a monadic process. Talents are caused through a monadic process since the causal mechanism which determines one person's latent capacities to acquire skills does not affect anyone else's. Obviously, parents' talent-generating mechanisms - genes - can affect their children's through inheritance. This is identical to the effect of parents' genes in the weight example. The point is that the effectiveness of one person's genes is independent of anyone else's. Talent is genetic her parent. Talent is descent from the parents. If the parents talented singing definitely her son had an aptitude singing also though not the same exactly like her parents.

2. Woman's struggle enacted by Elizabeth Bennet that taken in *Pride* and *Prejudice* novel by Jane Austen

Women's struggle is included in feminism. In this part, the researcher tells about women's struggle in socialist feminism. And the women's struggle that reflected by Elizabeth Bennet to get equality rights with other in the level social.

According to Green (2001: 300) struggle means great efforts that are done by one person group to against both of oppression and issue. Women's struggle to against oppression is not one, but many efforts to do. Such as, struggle to against physical oppression, crude word, sexual harassment and physiological oppression. Those are done to get women's independence and equality in a life.

In this research, the researcher found two kind of struggle. There are:

a. Struggle to against physical oppression

Struggle to against physical oppression means that the woman try to struggle against the physical oppression that do by men or others. Struggle to against physical oppression can describe like oppression about Elizabeth Bennet appearance and character.

b. Struggle to against psychological oppression

Struggle to against psychological oppression means that the women against oppression that include to psychological. Struggle to against psychological oppression can describe like when Elizabeth Bennet get oppression from Mr. Collins to refuse his engaged. Elizabeth Bennet try to resist his oppress with give reason but Mr. Collins does not believe with her reason and oppress Elizabeth very hard.

CONCLUSION

This conclusion have two points, first, In Pride and Prejudice novel, Elizabeth Bennet shows the socialist feminism of social inequality. Based on the finding and discussion show that Elizabeth Bennet experiences two dimension of social inequality. The first dimension is monadic and relational attribute and I found money (income) and social status as an example. The second dimension is monadic and relational process and I found talent as an example. Second, In *Pride and Prejudice* novel, Elizabeth Bennet shows the socialist feminism of woman's struggle. Based on finding and discussion show that Elizabeth Bennet experience two kinds of struggle. There is struggle to against physical oppression and struggle to against physiological oppression.
